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Where to go when: Summer 2016

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From seeing an Atlanta Braves baseball game to attending the Reykjavik Jazz Festival in Iceland, here's where to go this summer.



Marrakech: Qatar Airways is now flying to Marrakech, and with the recent opening of several new riad hotels, it's an appealing time to visit. The colourful Riad Goloboy, located in the Sidi Mimoun quarter of the medina, offers eight differently decorated rooms and suites, and views of the Atlas Mountains and the Mamounia Gardens. (from £55 [Dh294] per night, including taxes; riadgoloboy.com) The Almaha Marrakech is a spacious and bright property, inspired by Charles Baudelaire's poem *Invitation au Voyage* (from €315 [Dh1,687] per person, including taxes; almahamarrakech.com). The Oasis Festival, from September 16-18, fuses traditional food and entertainment with contemporary music (theoasisfest.com). Sun Trails tour group offers a 10-day tour of the country, starting in Casablanca and moving on to Rabat, Meknes, Fez, Erg Chebbi, Marrakech and Essaouira. Prices start from €2,395 (Dh9,942) per person, based on a two-person stay, including taxes (sun-trails.com)
